PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The programme is designed for **children up to Class 5**. Activities are adapted based on the child's age and comfort level.

Little Creators

Ages 5-6

A playful introduction to **colours, clay, rhythm, stories, movement** and simple roleplay.



Focus Areas:

Motor skills • Expression • Listening • Participation • Confidence



Typical Activities:

Colour play, clay models, action songs, story-based art and simple movement games

Young Explorers

Ages 7-8

A guided creative journey where children explore **art techniques, storytelling, rhythm, group activities** and theme-based projects.



Focus Areas:

Imagination • Teamwork • Basic technique
Creative confidence • Communication



Typical Activities:

Poster making, folk art, craft, short skits, rhythm games and group performances

Creative Thinkers

Ages 9-10 / Class 5

A more structured creative experience with **portfolio-style projects, presentations, design thinking** and performance exposure.



Focus Areas:

Skill building • Original ideas • Presentation
Collaboration • Creative problem-solving



Typical Activities:

Character design, storyboards, clay/craft projects, stage activities, cultural themes and showcase preparation

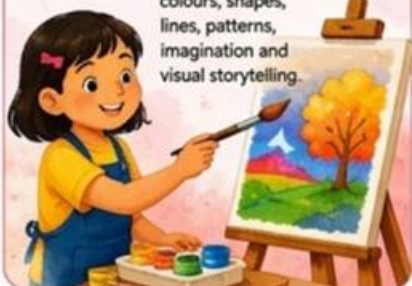
Discover the World of Fine Arts

Children experience six creative disciplines that build imagination, confidence, expression and lifelong learning skills.

The Six Fine Arts

1 Painting

- Children explore colours, shapes, lines, patterns, imagination and visual storytelling.



2 Sculpture

- Children work with clay, craft, paper models and simple 3D forms to build hands-on creativity.



3 Music

- Children experience rhythm, sound, listening, voice and simple musical expression.



4 Dance

- Children explore movement, coordination, rhythm, body expression and stage confidence.



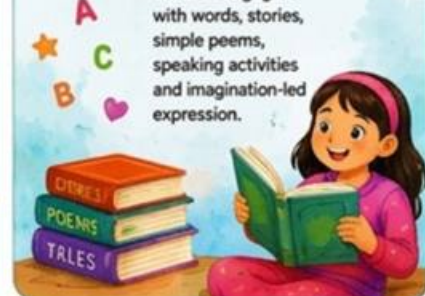
5 Drama / Acting

- Children learn storytelling, roleplay, expression, voice and confidence through performance-based activities.



6 Poetry / Literature

- Children engage with words, stories, simple poems, speaking activities and imagination-led expression.

6-MONTH CURRICULUM SNAPSHOT

A Structured Creative Journey Across 26 Weeks

The programme is planned as a 6-month journey. Each week combines multiple art forms so that children stay engaged and experience creativity in different ways.

Creative Confidence

Introduction to the six fine arts through colours, rhythm, movement, stories and self-expression.

PHASE 2

WEEKS

5-8



Values Through Art

Kindness, empathy, discipline, teamwork, gratitude and respect through painting, drama, music and poetry.

PHASE 3

3

WEEKS

9-12



Indian Culture & Heritage

Folk arts, festivals, monuments and Indian stories explored through art, craft, music, dance and drama.

PHASE 4

WEEKS

13-16



World Cultures

Children discover countries, cultures, music, dance and stories from around the world.

17-20



Nature, Sustainability & Safety

Seasons, animals, environment, personal safety and confidence through creative activities.

Future Skills & Showcase Preparation

Creative exercise, design, imagination, stage confidence and portfolio preparation.

25-26



Exposure & Celebration

Creative exposure activity where feasible, final showcase, certificate and parent sharing.

SAMPLE WEEKLY EXPERIENCES



Kindness & Empathy Week

Children may create a kindness tree through painting, perform a small helping-a-friend roleplay, recite simple kindness lines and participate in a friendship rhythm activity.



Indian Folk Arts Week

Children may explore a simple folk-art style, listen to regional music, try basic folk movements and create a colourful culture-inspired artwork.



Nature & Seasons Week

Children may paint the seasons, create rain and wind sounds, move like trees or flowers and share simple nature lives.



Stage Confidence Week

Children may practise voice, posture, expression, movement and group coordination as preparation for the final showcase.

Programme Outcomes



Creative Portfolio

A collection of selected artworks, craft pieces, theme-based activities and creative projects.



Performance Exposure

Opportunities to participate in group activities such as roleplay, rhythm, movement, poetry or stage presentation.



Parent-Visible Progress

Regular photos, videos or activity updates to help parents see how their child is participating and growing.



Confidence Building

Children are encouraged to speak, present, perform, create and share their work with pride.



Certificate & Showcase

The programme concludes with a creative showcase or sharing session, along with a completion certificate.



Next Step Guidance

Parents receive a broad understanding of the child's interest areas across visual arts, performance, music, storytelling, craft or mixed creative learning.

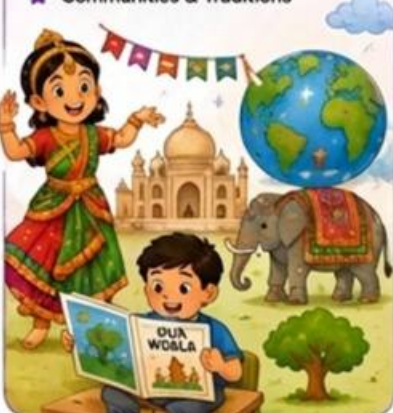

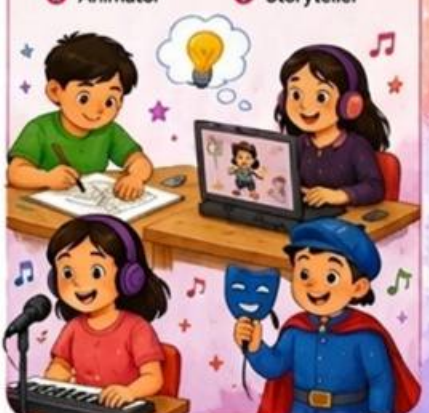
